

Procedure for graduate credit

Thank you so much for your interest in pursuing graduate credit through the University of North Texas. The unit you create in the Intel Teach to the Future program may be submitted to fulfill the requirements of CECS 5500 Section 021. Since this section is restricted to those participating in the Intel Teach to the Future program, a clearance code is required to register. Since this code changes every semester, simply email Romona Gibson at Gibson@coefs.coe.unt.edu and she will be happy to give you the current code.

Procedures for applying for this credit are as follows:

1. Apply for admission to University of North Texas as a graduate student (\$25 non-refundable fee). If you apply as "non-degree seeking," you may take up to 12 hours of graduate credit without taking the GRE. Application available online at <http://www.tsgs.unt.edu/appform3.htm>. All deadlines can be found on the university web site.
2. Upon acceptance, register for CECS 5500 section 021 (get clearance code at that time). All application tuition and fees (including distance learning) apply.
3. Burn completed unit on a CD and mail during that semester to:

4. You will receive a grade for the class.

You do not have to take CECS 5500 in the same semester you do the Intel Teach to the Future training. This class will be available for several more semesters.
