

Intel® Teach to the Future  
 Participant Teacher  
 Training Guidelines

**The Intel Teach to the Future curriculum was developed in a modular format to allow for a flexible delivery schedule. However, in order to maintain high quality, the following guidelines have been set for scheduling the 40-hour Intel Teach to the Future training:**

- <sup>a</sup> Begin Module 1 no later than October 29, 2001.
  - <sup>a</sup> Complete modules in order.
  - <sup>a</sup> Complete Module 6 by December 31, 2001.
  - <sup>a</sup> Deliver all 10 modules within 4 months of the starting date.
- (2 modules may be covered in one day but deliver training in blocks no longer than 8 hours each, with days or open lab time scheduled in between for participant practice and homework.)
- <sup>a</sup> Training may not be delivered in less than seven consecutive days.

**Suggested training schedule for delivery in the shortest amount of days:** (not recommended).

**The curriculum may be broken up into less than 4-hour blocks only if the following conditions are met:**

<sup>a</sup> Training blocks are scheduled at least 1 hour in length.

<sup>a</sup> Each Module is completed within the same workweek. Examples: Monday, September 18 from 3-5 PM and Wednesday, September 20 from 3-5 PM; Monday-Thursday, September 18-21, 3-4 PM.

<sup>a</sup> The entire class (all 20 participants) meets during the specified times as a whole group. Example: If the schedule is Tues and Thurs 3-5 PM, all participants must be together at these appointed times and dates.
